***Are there themes, forms, aesthetic decisions, etc. that you always return to in your photographic work? Do you return to again and again in your photographic work?**

No. Generally speaking, I can say that the theme is that I take photos in our house. Quite casually, without any great intention or goal.

***Do you work in the moment or specifically within the framework of a theme that you have thought about beforehand?**

Both and. I prefer to work spontaneously, or out of boredom, then I wander around the house and see what's around. Once I was given a theme for an exhibition 'Consumers of the present'. I tried to take photos on the street. But I didn't succeed. I found what I was looking for at home and the photos turned out good.

*** Your husband is a painter, and you chose to photograph and paint what didn't fall on the canvas, but rather as blobs on the floor. What fascinated you about this?**

I only realised what was fascinating about the photos after the first prints. At first, it's a kind of documentation. I feel my way around the studio with the camera. Then it's a decision as to which shot is suitable for a print that has a certain atmosphere beyond the actual photo. Probably quite normal decisions that every artist or photographer has to make.
